Moreover, he worked for an ODR Hong Kong based institution, managing the business development and the administration of disputes.

Alonso has a global overview on arbitration matters, considering his experience from different standpoints. He has prepared written submissions, gathered relevant evidence, drafted procedural orders, and prepared executive legal analysis for arbitral tribunals. Furthermore, he has dealt with several digital tools to conduct virtual hearings, share documents, and manage the document production stage.
