

Schedule of Fees for Appointment Only matters

This Schedule of Fees is effective as of 1 January 2023 and is applicable to all arbitration, mediation, expert determination and other ADR proceedings in which the Australian Centre for International Commercial Arbitration (ACICA) is designated as the Appointing Authority only, pursuant to the UNCITRAL arbitration rules or other ad hoc rules or procedures agreed by the parties, and whether for the purposes of nominating or appointing any individual, determining a challenge against any individual who has been appointed in such proceedings or any other function of the Appointing Authority in accordance with the agreement of the parties.

A reference to "dollars" or "\$" is to Australian currency. All fee amounts set out in this Schedule exclude GST (to the extent that it is payable). ACICA may gross up any payment for a taxable supply under its Rules on account of GST. ACICA reserves the right to recover GST from a party at a later date if the GST treatment of a supply is subsequently determined to be incorrect.

Any bank charges incurred on any transfer of funds by the parties to ACICA shall be borne exclusively by the party or parties transferring the funds.

Request Fee

An initial, non-refundable, request fee of \$2,000 (per arbitrator appointment) is payable in advance with the request for ACICA to act as Appointing Authority.

Administrative Charges

Time spent by the ACICA Secretariat in connection with the engagement (appointment, nomination, challenge or other work required):

- Associate: AUD250 per hour
- Counsel: AUD350 per hour
- Secretary General: AUD400 per hour

Expenses incurred by the Secretariat in connection with the functions of Appointing Authority (such as postage, telephone etc), and additional support services will be invoiced.

Settlement of Charges

The parties will be notified of a nomination, appointment, or challenge decision when ACICA's charges have been settled in full.

An advance deposit of costs may be requested by the Secretariat with regard to ACICA fees and expenses. ACICA reserves the right to not proceed with the provision of services unless requisite funds are held.

Limitation of liability

Neither ACICA nor its members, officers, servants or agents shall be liable for any act or omission in connection with ACICA acting as Appointing Authority.
